01. Thanksgiving & Praise

// Enter into His gates with thanksgiving, and into His courts with praise. Be thankful to Him, and bless His name.

Psalm 100:4

Let's offer God thanksgiving and praise! Be specific. Allow your mind to think upon His goodness and verbalize it. Thank Him for what He has done and what He is about to do in your life!



02. Repentance & Surrender

The Lord is near to those who have a broken heart, and saves such as have a contrite spirit.

Psalm 34:18

Draw near to God and He will draw near to you. Cleanse your hands, you sinners; and purify your hearts, you double-minded. Lament and mourn and weep! Let your laughter be turned to mourning and your joy to gloom. Humble yourselves in the sight of the Lord, and He will lift you up.

James 4:8-10

Prayer Points

- ✓ I humble myself before You. I know you resist the proud and arrogant, and You give grace to the humble.
- ✓ I confess my sin. Forgive me of pride and self-will. Forgive me for straying. I repent for being spiritually passive. I repent for sometimes going through the motions and external formalities, while allowing things to suffer on the inside. I repent for not denying myself.
- ✓ I repent for the areas of personal consecration in which I have lack - in prayer, in fasting, in Bible reading, in sharing the gospel, in sharing what I have with those who are in need. Forgive me for allowing seasons of complacency in my prayer life. Forgive me for a lack of intercession. Forgive me for allowing these important things to dwindle and in some cases, to die. **Help me to return to my first love by doing the first works!**
- ✓ I surrender fully. I present myself to You. I make myself available to You. I lay my life upon the altar again.
- ✓ **I want to be Your disciple** – to deny myself, take up my cross daily, and follow You!



03. Forgiveness & Release

“ For if you forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you. But if you do not forgive men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses.

Matthew 6:14-15

“ Judge not, and you shall not be judged. Condemn not, and you shall not be condemned. Forgive, and you will be forgiven.

Luke 6:37

Prayer Points

- ✓ I acknowledge the pain I have experienced in life, sometimes as a result of my choices and sometimes from the actions of others. Yet I know You said if we do not forgive others of their trespasses against us, neither will our Father forgive our trespasses. Jesus, I recall Your command - "Forgive, and you shall be forgiven." I understand that if I release others, then I will be released.
- ✓ I am imperfect and I stand in need of Your forgiveness today. I want and need forgiveness to flow freely in my life. So help me, Lord, to extend forgiveness to others.
- ✓ You said that I should even forgive someone who sins against me seventy times seven! Increase my faith, Lord!
- ✓ I want to pursue peace with everyone. I don't want a root of bitterness to spring up in my life.
- ✓ I take inventory of my life. I reflect upon those who have sinned against or offended me. Right now, with the help of the Holy Ghost, I freely extend forgiveness to _____, _____, and _____. I forgive and release them in Jesus' name!



04. Renewal of Spiritual Passion

“not lagging in diligence, fervent in spirit, serving the Lord

Romans 12:11

Prayer Points

- ✓ **Forgive me** for lukewarmness. I want to be red hot and on fire for You, Lord! Forgive me for abandoning my first love!
- ✓ I need a renewal. **Renew my strength as I wait upon You.** Renew my inward man day by day, so I won't lose heart. Let me be renewed in the spirit of my mind and put on the new man which was created in true righteousness and holiness! Help me not to believe the old lies which plagued me, but help me to put on the new man who is renewed in knowledge according to the image of God Who created me!
- ✓ **Restore what the enemy has stolen and those things I have let go.** Restore the joy of my salvation and uphold me by Your Spirit! Restore me and cause Your face to shine upon me! Restore spiritual and emotional health to me!
- ✓ **Revive me according to Your Word!** Revive me in Your righteousness! Help me to regain diligence! I reject apathy! Breath life into me again and animate me with Your Spirit! Resurrect the spiritual things which have grown cold and stale! Quicken and empower me!



05. Hunger & Faith

“Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, For they shall be filled.

Matthew 5:6

Prayer Points

- ✓ Jesus, restore our hunger for the things of God!
- ✓ I hunger for Your Word. Help me to go deeper in the Word. Help me to esteem it highly, more important than the food I eat. Give me insight, understanding, and revelation from Your Word!
- ✓ I hunger for a more consistent and powerful prayer life. Help me to go deeper in prayer. I want to do more than petition You for things, I want to be a prayer warrior! I want to seek Your face. I want to hear Your voice! I want to dwell in the secret place of the Most High! I want my fervent prayers, my supplications, to be powerful and effective!
- ✓ I thirst for righteousness. I want to not only receive Your righteousness, but to practice righteousness in my own life. You said, "Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they shall be filled." Fill us Lord! Fill us with everything You are pouring out!
- ✓ We drive out doubt in Jesus' name! We drive out unbelief in Jesus' name! We drive out distrust in Jesus' name! Increase our faith! Build it! And let us live by faith!



06. Fruit-bearing (1)

**“By this My Father is glorified,
that you bear much fruit; so you
will be My disciples.**

John 15:8

**“...the fruit of the Spirit is love,
joy, peace, longsuffering,
kindness, goodness, faithfulness,
gentleness, self-control. Against
such there is no law.**

Galatians 5:22-23

Prayer Points

- ✓ Jesus, You told us that You were the vine and that the Father would remove every branch that does not bear fruit in You. You said, *“Every branch in Me that does not bear fruit He takes away; and every branch that bears fruit He prunes, that it may bear more fruit.”* I don't want to be a fruitless follower! **If I need pruning in order to bear fruit, then prune me Lord.** The Lord gives and the Lord takes away!
- ✓ **I want to abide in You, and I want You to abide in me.** I need Your Word to live in me. I can't bear fruit unless I abide in You, Lord! Help me. Without You I can do nothing. I recognize that bearing fruit brings You glory!
- ✓ As I allow Your Spirit to work in my life, help me to bring forth **love**. Help me to love You and love others well.
- ✓ The **joy** of the Lord is my strength! Joy - The joy of the Lord is my strength! Help me to hold joy tightly and recognize that my joy is not determined by my circumstance. I choose joy! Let Your joy remain in me and let my joy remain full! "In Your presence is fullness of joy; at Your right hand are pleasures forevermore." The more I am in Your presence, Lord, the more joy I have! Help my life to be a testimony of deep abiding joy! Let it overflow from my life!



06. Fruit-bearing (2)

Prayer Points

- ✓ Help me to bear the fruit of **peace**. Help me pursue peaceful relationships. Help me to be at peace with myself. Help me to not plant seeds of doubt or contention or discord, but to sow seeds of peace. You said the fruit of righteousness is sown in peace by those who make peace. Help me to be peacemakers!
- ✓ Help me to bear the fruit of **longsuffering**. You are longsuffering with us and abundant in mercy. Help me to reflect that in my life.
- ✓ Help me to be **kind**. I want to treat others with kindness and tenderheartedness. Let kindness flow from me as my first response. Help me to be kind and quick to forgive.
- ✓ Through the work of Your Holy Spirit bring forth moral **goodness** from my life. I want to be a reflection of Your goodness, holiness, and great grace.
- ✓ Bring forth **faithfulness**. You, oh God, are always and forever faithful. Help me to be faithful in every area of my life. Help there to be no unfaithfulness in me!
- ✓ Help me to be **gentle**. You said You were gentle and lowly in heart. Help me to treat others with gentleness. Help me to restore the backslidden in a spirit of gentleness. Help me to deal with others in a spirit of gentleness.



06. Fruit-bearing (3)

Prayer Points

- ✓ And help me to bring forth the spiritual fruit of **self-control**. I need temperance in my life. I want to add this to our faith and grow in this area. With the empowerment of Your Spirit, help me exercise self-control in my desires, in my relationships, in my emotions, in my attitude, and in all of my actions.
- ✓ I know that those who are Christ's have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires. I bring my flesh to the cross, Jesus!
- ✓ Help me to live in the Spirit and help me to walk in the Spirit!



07. Giftedness & Ministry Calling (1)

the manifestation of the Spirit is given to each one for the profit of all: for to one is given the word of wisdom through the Spirit, to another the word of knowledge through the same Spirit, to another faith by the same Spirit, to another gifts of healings by the same Spirit, to another the working of miracles, to another prophecy, to another discerning of spirits, to another different kinds of tongues, to another the interpretation of tongues.

Pursue love, and desire spiritual gifts...

Prayer Points

- ✓ I don't want to be ignorant of the spiritual gifts You give to build up the church, nor do I want to be selfish by neglecting them. Your Word commands me to pursue love and desire spiritual gifts. Help me to do that!
- ✓ Your Word declares that You have appointed people to many ministry offices and service gifts such as apostles, prophets, pastors and teachers, evangelists, ministry of administration, helps, ministry of serving, exhortation and encouragement, giving, leading, and showing mercy. You've also given the spiritual gifts including words of wisdom, words of knowledge, faith, gifts of healing, working of miracles, prophecy, discerning of spirits, different kinds of tongues, and interpretation of tongues.
- ✓ I desire every good gift from You, so that I may help edify and minister to the church! Help me to desire Your very best gifts and seek to excel in the gifting You choose to give me! Your Word says that You distribute Your spiritual gifts to each individual as You choose. **I seek to receive Your gifts so that the church will be edified.** I seek these so I may be of spiritual help to others, not for myself.
- ✓ **Let Your Spirit be manifested in my life!** Flow through me and help me to walk in holy anointing and appointing!



07. Giftedness & Ministry Calling (2)

More Prayer Points

- ✓ According to Ephesians 2, I am Your workmanship! I am Your handiwork! I am made to be Your masterpiece! Help me to live and align my life accordingly!
- ✓ **You have created me in Christ Jesus for good works.** I want to live life in the purpose for which I've been created. You have already prepared these works so that I should walk in them! I've been born again so I can live and walk in Your purpose!
- ✓ **I am called according to Your purpose!** You've called me with a holy calling, not because of my own works, but according to Your own purpose and grace! I am pursuing Your purpose and aligning myself with Your mission for my life! I want nothing more! I'll seek nothing less! I'm settling for nothing else!
